7. English Level (English Placement Test)

All newly-admitted UNIST students are required to be assigned the English level. For international students, the level is assigned based on the English test scores submitted at the time of admission. If students have scores other than TOEFL or IELTS, or if student wishes to, they can take the English placement test to determine their level. Students are required to take English courses based on their level. Such students without English level will not be allowed to register English courses

8. Foreign Registration

- Foreigners staying in Korea for more than 90 days must complete the foreign registration at a local(Ulsan) immigration office within 90 days from the date of entry. Simply receiving your visa is not the last step to registration, and those with visas must receive an FRC to finalize their sojourn documentation. It is illegal to stay in Korea for more than 90 days without being registered, regardless of your visa at entry. Please be sure to check for the most recent information at (<http://hikorea.go.kr>) before your visit, or by calling the immigration hotline at 1345 (no area code needed).
